### Audio & Video at Corflu Glitter

Las Vegas introduced the Virtual Consuite at Corflu Silver. It was wildly successful, subsequent Corflus repeated it and it has become a tradition.

JoHn Hardin, Don Miller and Peter Sullivan are in charge of all Corflu Glitter audio and video activities.

Here a brief rundown of our audio and video:

**The Virtual Consuite.** We hope everyone who reads *Glitter* will be able to come to Las Vegas for Corflu, but we understand that isn't likely, or even possible. The Virtual Consuite permits anyone with an internet connection to interact with fans at Corflu Glitter.

**Video Interviews.** Corflu Glitter's camera-toters will circulate through the con, taping short video segments. They'll be armed with some intriguing questions so that the segments can be edited into coherent video files for distribution throughout Fandom.

**Video of Corflu Events.** We will video as much of the program and major events like the Opening Ceremony as conditions permit. We're investigating the cost of providing streaming video and will do as much as we can, finances permitting.

**Video and Audio Programming.** As previously announced, Don Miller will host an informal program of audio and video of interest to fans on Friday afternoon and is also promising a varied menu of vintage video on Saturday evening for fans who want a little breather from the parties.

### Fan Bowl I Still Rolling Along

Frank Lunney has announced the formation of the first four-fan team to compete in next April's Fan Bowl I. The international aggregation, as-yet unnamed, features Frank, Graham Charnock, Pat Charnock and Dan Steffan.
